## Congratulations Christine Vorhies, CBJ's 2024 Women of Influence!



**Christine Vorhies'** relationship with Camp Courageous goes back to some of her earliest years. Chris' parents, Dan & Carol Vorhies, of Monticello, IA, were involved in Camp Courageous for most the Camp's life. Seldom did a day go by that Dan & Carol weren't doing something for Camp. Dan & Carol were both Honorary Board Members, the highest honor that can be bestowed by the Camp on anyone. Other Honorary Board Members included Tait Cummins and Leo Greco.

Chris set the Camp on fire for years, when she would lead Aegon, (later to become Transamerica), for a month set aside each year to promote, support, and advocate for Camp Courageous. There were raffles and competition between departments. They would compete to see which department could produce the best auction item(s) for the Pineapple Gala. Every basket, which was sometimes as big as canoe, filled with \$1,000s in supplies, became top live auction items. It would take an entire straight truck to pick-up what they collected for Camp...those were truly 'glory days.' With the trend toward health and wellness, Chris switched gears to help start the Camp Courageous Sprint Triathlon, with the Title Sponsor being Transamerica. There she played a key role in making the event a premier race in Eastern Iowa, and for the vast majority of participants, it was their first triathlon. She accomplished the goal of making more and more people set health goals, like completing a triathlon. Once again raising awareness for Camp Courageous, raising money for the Camp, and making, thousands of people, healthier, over the years.

Chris's entire life has been a labor of love, from Transamerica to her family, to her friends, to the community...everything she does, she gives 100%. Unfortunately, her dad, Dan, one of the nicest people one could ever meet, passed in 2021 at the age of 80 from Parkinson's Disease, but her mom, Carol, stays active. Chris, is one incredible individual, blessed with two wonderful parents, who were all about giving back to their community. In addition, her grandmother just passed, at the age 104. At one time Chris' grandparents were the longest married couple in Iowa, 78.5 years!



Camp Courageous has worked closely with **Robin Mixdorf**, the recently retired President, President, and CEO of Meth-Wick Community, in a variety of ways, over the past few decades. Robin, and her husband, Jon, as they plan for their next chapter, in a new location, have been very generous to Camp Courageous, donating many items from their home, things Camp can use, and items Camp can use for its garage sale. 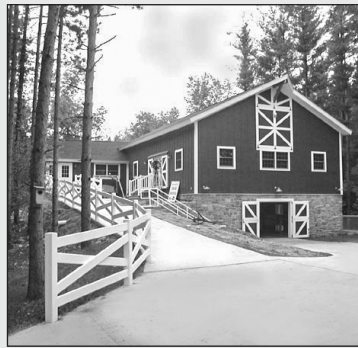

These units included an exceptionally high efficient furnace and water heater in one unit. Amana donated enough units to cover the office, lodge, and three camper cabins! Jerry and Jack installed each unit, which was a challenge since there was no duct work or LP lines in the buildings. Over the years, Jerry Lindner worked closely with Camp Courageous Super Volunteer Jerry Rohr. Jerry Rohr was a Jack-Of-All-Trades and a huge asset to Camp Courageous. Jerry Rohr was always fixing things at Camp and had an open relationship with Jerry Lindner, to get whatever Camp needed from Jerry Lindner's shop.

In 2000 Jerry Lindner had quadruple by-pass surgery and in 2007, Jerry's wife, Jane passed. Then with Covid, it was time to hang up his wrenches in 2021. Jerry has stayed active with Camp Courageous and Special Olympics. He remarked how he could not believe how the Camp has grown over the decades. Jerry experienced firsthand being a coach for the local Special Olympics Baseball Team on the Camp's new Handicapped Accessible Multi-Purpose Field. And how nice it was to have Emily take them to the State Special Olympics in Ames, in the Camp Bus.

Recently Jerry Lindner donated his HVAC and plumbing supplies to Camp Courageous. Jerry Lindner marveled over the incredibly hard working and dedicated maintenance staff camp had, to move all the items. There were many truck and trailer loads. Camp Courageous sincerely thanks Jerry Lindner for his decades of support. Many wonderful memories and a lot of growth, thanks to Jerry, his family, and friends.

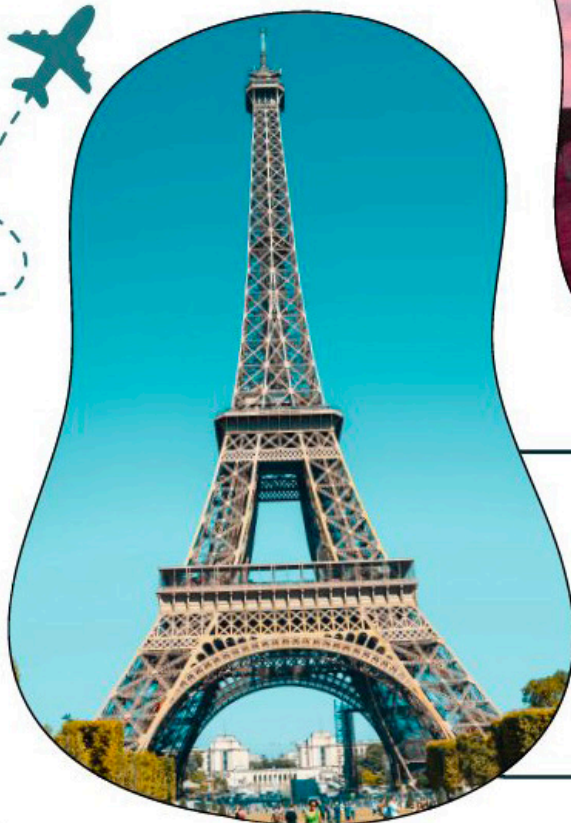

# Charlie's remembrances on some of Camp's loved ones...



It is with great sadness Camp Courageous learned of the passing of **Delbert Jackson**, 91, of Bellevue, IA. Delbert was an exceptionally good person. A person with the utmost integrity and kindness. He worked extremely hard...and lead by example. Over his 91-years there is an endless number of people's lives he touched...I was fortunate to be one...and Camp Courageous, that touches the lives of nearly 10,000 individuals with disabilities, was another. Camp is extremely humbled and honored that the Camp was selected for Delbert's memorials to come. Delbert and my relationship goes back over 50-years, as his son, Gerry and I were friends in a youth organization.

Delbert loved his country and was a veteran, having enlisted in the US Air Force in December 1952, then transitioned to the Air Force Reserve, then switched to the Army Reserve, where he eventually retired as a Master Sergeant.

He married Janice Mary Daniels on June 23, 1957, in Stockton, Illinois. Together, they raised seven children on a farm west of Bellevue. Jan was Delbert's lifelong love. In later years, they traveled the country and the world together. Sitting with Delbert, a few years after Janice's passing, one could still sense their deep love and devotion for each other, and the void Janice's passing caused Delbert.

Aside from raising a family, Delbert's accomplishments in life were many. First and foremost, he was a farmer, working the land and raising cattle (especially Murray Grays). He worked for the Post Office in Bellevue, where he eventually retired from that job. He constructed and renovated more than 32 homes and buildings in Bellevue and surrounding areas. He also drove trucks and buses later in life.

Delbert was a Freemason serving as the secretary of the Bellevue Masonic Lodge for many years. He was its Worshipful Master for several years. He also served in the Grand Lodge of Iowa.



Delbert 100% loved Bellevue, IA and was keen on giving back to his community in time, materials and treasurers. He was a past member of the Bellevue Jaycees and served as a Scoutmaster for the Boy Scouts. He was also an active member of both the First Presbyterian Church of Bellevue and the Green Island Congregational Church. Delbert also remodeled the old piano factory on the north

side into apartments, storage, and the Horizon Lanes bowling alley. He was also instrumental in creating J-J's Park so kids in that part of Bellevue have a safe place to play. The mold has been broken, with Delbert's passing...it will take many to do in the future, what this one person did in his lifetime... -Charlie Becker

**Sue Chapman**, 40+ Years As A Camp Courageous Advocate, Staffer, And Volunteer...Passes. Sue Whittle, was born June 25, 1962 in Dubuque, IA and grew up in rural Zwingle, IA where from her earliest days loved being outdoors in nature. She was a self-described hippie. A 1981 graduate of the Maquoketa Community Schools, Sue first came to Camp Courageous in the Fall of 1982, to be a counselor. She came with the experience of being a nurse's aid and loving to help others. She was described in her first evaluation as 'sweet, meek & quiet' counselor...a perfect personality for many campers. She did an exceptional job and was a huge hit with campers and staff alike. Sue left Camp in the Fall of 1983. But while at Camp she fell in love and would eventually marry her fellow counselor Steve Hunter on June 1, 1985 in Iowa City. Eventually they headed to Utah. Steve's health began to fail, and he passed on February 5, 1994.



While living in Utah Sue attended The University of Utah from 1990-1995, receiving a BA in Behavior Science and in 1994 she received Certification, also from the U of Utah in Drug/Alcohol Treatment, which became a lifetime interest. She came back to Camp Courageous in 1995 as the Nature Activity Specialist and stayed until 1998. She loved working with the camp animals and experiencing first-hand the joy they brought the campers. In 1995 she became a Medication Manager and would spend the rest of her life helping camp's nurses.



She would later marry Denny Chapman from Monticello in 2006, and from that marriage came a wonderful son, Zach...the most important thing in Sue's life. Denny passed in 2013.

During Sue's first time at Camp, we encouraged all staff to obtain their chauffeur's license, to broaden their capabilities to drive campers to and from the Lake at Central Park and other activities. While being tested, an eye exam discovered that Sue had a vision impairment and could no longer drive. Sue quickly became an exceptional walker and user of public transportation where available. One often saw Sue and Zach walking the streets of Monticello...which may have had a lot to do with Zach eventually becoming an exceptional long distance runner.

Sue loved all the campers and all the animals...but she also had a favorite, Heidi Altorfer. Sue was always so excited when Heidi attended Camp events.

Sue never was too far from Camp Courageous. Sue & Zach were very involved with Camp, with Zach doing his Eagle Scout Project at Camp. On November 8, 2021 Sue came back to Camp as a full time Volunteer Nature Directo after Zach's graduation and eventual desire to go to BYU

Sue took a year off volunteering at Camp Courageous to volunteer in Salt Lake City with the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. While in Salt Lake City she was diagnosed with cancer, but still had the opportunity to attend the wedding of her son Zach in July 2023. No one dreamed she would not be coming back to Camp Courageous, as she always did. Sue passed away on March 18, 2024, following a battle with pancreatic cancer.

One of Sue's many favorite songs was Bob Seger's, 'Against the Wind'. Sue had many challenges throughout her life, but she always approached them with a positive attitude and the vision that the future will be better. Sue's life has been an inspiration to many and her passing will continue to inspire many by the way she lived her life.

An evening to celebrate Sue's life was on Friday, April 5th, 2024, from 6:00 to 8:00 pm at Camp Courageous' Durgin Pavilion 12101 190th Street Monticello, IA 52310. It was a special time to share stories and to share in some of Sue's favorite foods (chicken, with the trimmings) favorite drink (Diet Coke) and a good selection of desserts. 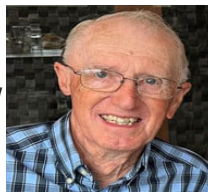

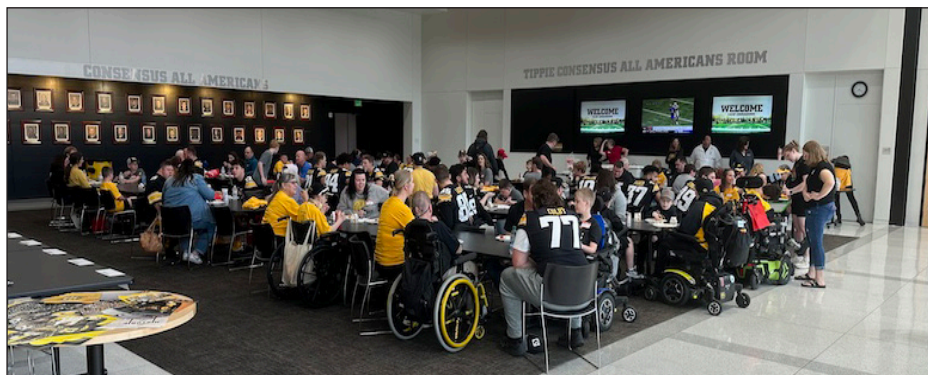
# Campers enjoy the 17th Annual Hawkeye Tailgate Huge Dream Come True for the Campers

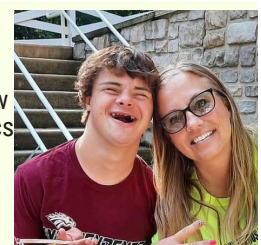

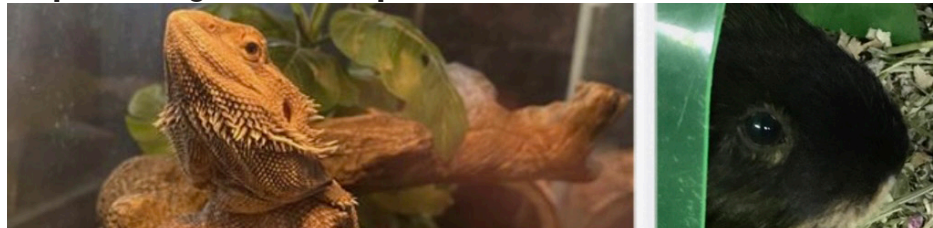

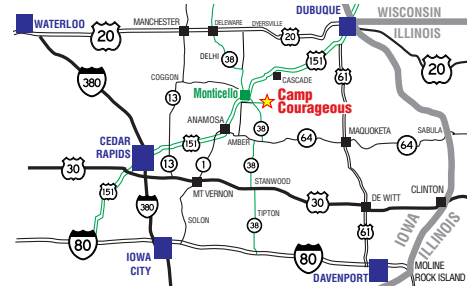


### How can I help?
