# Jeff Pitlik Named as 9-Who-Care Award Recipient for Camp Volunteer Work

Camp Courageous congratulates Jeff Pitlik for being selected as one of the '9-Who-Care Award' recipients! Each year, KCRG-TV9, and their Show You Care Sponsors, honor outstanding volunteers throughout Eastern Iowa. Nine finalists are chosen by an independent panel of judges. Jeff Pitlik, of Anamosa IA, was nominated by Camp Courageous.

Jeff Pitlik, was first introduced to Camp Courageous by Honorary Board Members Kay & Bill Pitlik. For decades 'Pitlik Dazes' was held for family and friends who gathered for food, fellowship, games, and to support Camp Courageous. During a casual visit, Jeff began talking about a pollinator idea and the rest has been a whirlwind of ideas and projects. Like so many things in Camp's life, we had been discussing Monarchs and pollinators at camp for years, but it took someone to change a dream into a reality... and that was Jeff.

After obtaining a degree in Business, Jeff began his career at Rockwell Collins in June, 1978. He spent the next 40 years there, retiring as a procurement specialist. During his time there, Jeff recognized the value of teamwork, communication and organization to achieve a goal. His past work experience as a project manager was a huge asset in his transition to volunteer work at camp. He was just what the Camp needed at a time when many big projects were on the drawing board.

Jeff enlisted the help of Pheasants Forever and their District Biologist to help Camp with the pollinator project. He went to local chapters for support and then to Mike Schmitz, the State Council President, to get involved. They had a huge statewide campaign to raise money to help Camp establish a pollinator area.

Jeff was then asked to volunteer to take over the Lake Todd project, which

represents 30 acres of land surrounding a 2-3 acre pond. He requested the support of North Star Fish Hatchery, who decided to donate thousands of fish to stock Lake Todd at no charge. Jeff also enlisted local merchants to donate fishing equipment for the campers. Jeff introduced Camp



Courageous to Kevin Bjornsen, who is in the pond management business. He volunteered to help revitalize Lake Todd to a beautiful, healthy, and productive lake. Kevin and Jeff were involved in restocking the Lake again in spring of 2019. Kevin donated a fish feeder at the Lake to provide optimal growth potential and a means of entertainment for the campers to watch at feeding time. This activity, offered twice a day during the summer, has become a huge hit for the campers.

He also oversaw a large prairie planting project, once again with the support of a Pheasants Forever Biologist, who

volunteered to do a huge layout of the entire Lake Todd area. He provided educational information on the process and value of a prescribed burn to enhance the beauty of the project for years to come. There were huge planting projects of trees and shrubs; hundreds of lilacs, weigelas, dogwoods, and nine barks to enhance the area with aromatic, and colorful year-round plants, again many being donated. Jeff lead groups of volunteer planters from church groups to Rockwell staff to accomplish this task. Jeff recruited the assistance of the Jones County Conservation Department to complete a prescribed controlled burn in the Lake Todd prairie project. Due to the great partnership over the years with Camp Courageous, they have agreed to occasionally monitor and provide suggestions to maintain the beauty of the project.

Jeff oversaw a Boy Scout Eagle Scout Project to make blue bird houses. These 20 to 30 bird houses created nesting sites for one of Iowa's most beautiful birds, bringing another group of young people into the Camp Courageous fold. Then, as the main contact with Iowa Big, Jeff helped a group of high school students take on a Raised Garden project, enabling campers

dormitory.

In the end, through their estate, they gave a donation to Camp Courageous that will give forever. Any unspecified gifts given to Camp Courageous through a will, goes into the [Camp's Foundation](#),

which provides the Camp income forever, which has been key to getting the Camp through COVID-19. It was always important to Francis and Jean that Camp Courageous was run on donations, without government funding, formal sponsorship or people paid to raise money for the camp... even throughout the Pandemic. Their memory and legacy of good, hard working, caring individuals will live on forever at Camp.

**Francis and Jean Pitlik** were involved with Camp Courageous for decades. When Francis passed away at the end of 2012, Jean wanted to make sure his white 1999 Dodge Dakota Pick-Up Truck came to camp. That pick-up is still being used almost daily. Being a Pitlik (relative of Honorary Board Members Kay & Bill Pitlik, who were among some of the camp's first board members), Francis & Jean were involved in everything Camp, from [Pineapple Sales](#) and [Galas to Open Houses](#). Over the years they gave needed items ranging from a large aquarium for campers to enjoy a variety of fish, to a riding lawn mower. In addition, they supported all the big projects like the indoor pool and staff

using wheelchairs to be able to garden. Jeff and Iowa Big Leader Mark Matson, provided the focus and enthusiasm to the group representing juniors and seniors at a variety of Cedar Rapids/Marion High Schools. They made presentations, had many educational opportunities, and it became an award winning project. The students learned and understood the value of this project, and worked to provide funding, resulting in the donation of a lot of materials.

Jeff introduced Camp Courageous to famous wildlife artist, Greg Bordignon, who created a beautiful painting of the Lake Todd/Durgin Pavilion area. The painting was exceptional, and the prints became a successful fund raiser for the Camp. He also helped design a wild edible trail, so campers may enjoy what nature has to offer. This project is expected to be completed in the spring of 2021,w

In his most recent volunteer project, Jeff led the team to build the [Mainliner Memorial Park](#), described by many as the most heartwarming part of Camp Courageous. It is located, inside the train loop, next to the Durgin Pavilion at Lake Todd and stands as a memorial to all those who have, or are currently serving in the United States Armed Forces, the heroes on the frontline of the COVID-19 pandemic, and everyone who has sacrificed and helped during these unprecedented times.

Jeff and Royce Pitlik are regulars at almost every Camp event. Jeff recognizes his wife as a key factor in the success of the volunteer projects over the years. Both are totally engaged with Camp. But what does the future hold for Camp Courageous and Jeff Pitlik? When Camp was in need of someone to lead the building of a Multi-Purpose Field, Jeff immediately came to mind. When asked, he of course said yes! In addition, Jeff is researching a bird/nature sanctuary in memory of his Aunt Jean and Uncle Francis Pitlik, along with wood carvings, an interseeding prairie grass project with wild flowers and much more. Camp hopes Jeff never truly retires.

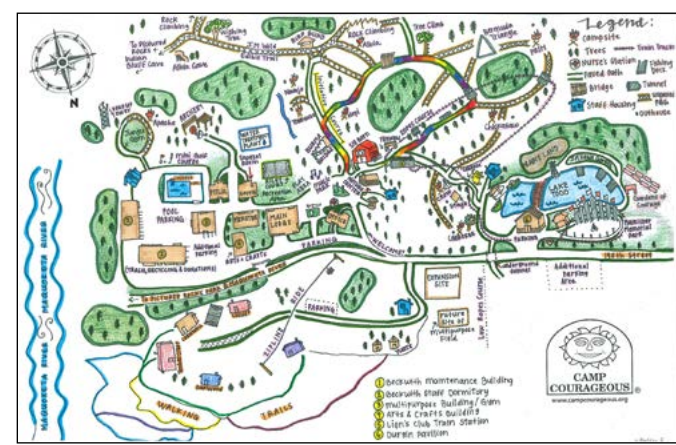

## How can I help?

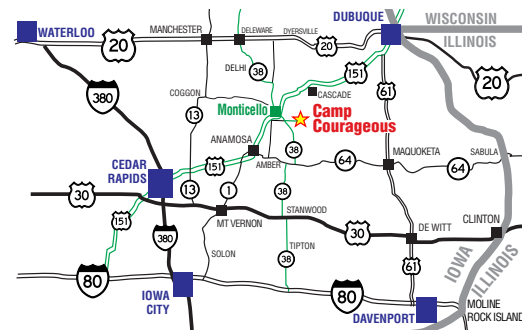
