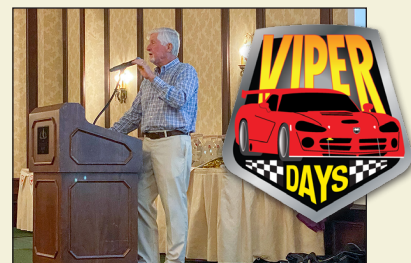
Winnie loved her church and was so proud of the direction it was going and was involved in every part of the church over the years.
