This heartfelt initiative was sparked by Ginger and Dr. Dan Franz, who recognized a significant need to encourage people to leave their homes, immerse themselves in nature, and revel in the sun, wind, and the surrounding beauty. It brought genuine joy to many individuals.

A Trishaw is a three-wheeled pedalpowered vehicle with a pilot positioned at the rear and a front passenger seat that offers splendid views. These Trishaws are crafted in Copenhagen and are primarily designed to transport adults, particularly the elderly and those with mobility challenges – a population that includes many of the Camp Courageous campers.

As time passed, the organization in Rapid City, South Dakota, dissolved, leading Eloise to contemplate the idea of introducing a Trishaw as a wonderful new activity at Camp Courageous, given the abundance of hard-surfaced trails available there. To bring this vision to life, Dan and Ginger rented a U-Haul and transported the Trishaw to Camp Courageous.

For those interested in learning more about this remarkable program, you can visit CyclingWithoutAge.org. Here are some notable facts about Cycling Without Age: It was first invented in 2012 in Copenhagen. The organization boasts active chapters in 39 countries. They have an impressive fleet of 4,900 Trishaws. Over 39,000 cycle pilots have received training. They have provided more than 3 million rides and have served over 650,000 people. The oldest pilot, Jørgen Hass from Denmark, is 90 years old, and the oldest passenger, Pauline Angleman from California, is an impressive 110 years old.

4:00 PM, Wednesdays from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM, and Saturdays from 9:00 AM to Noon. These dedicated volunteers engage in tasks such as item sorting, shelf stocking, and cashier duties. Their invaluable efforts are instrumental in ensuring the sale's smooth operation and continued success.

The Manchester Garage Sale serves as a benefit for Camp Courageous, offering new to lightly used items at significantly reduced prices. The range of items includes clothing, coats, boots, shoes in both adult and youth sizes, housewares, jewelry, purses, bedding, decorations, books, toys, videos, audio CDs, wall hangings, furniture, and more. The sale features hundreds of square feet of items available at bargain prices. Payment is accepted in both cash and credit cards (with a \$10 minimum purchase for credit card transactions).

The Garage Sale had its beginnings in the garage of former board member and parent of a camper, Alfred Egger of Manchester, IA. It started in 1980 and, following Alfred's passing, relocated from one available space to another within Manchester, all provided at no cost. Initially led by Alfred's assistant volunteer, Jackie Snyder, the MGS transitioned to a committee-led operation after Jackie's health no longer permitted her to lead.

Camp was saddened when learning of the passing of Bob Goodyear, 85, a beloved figure in Monticello, Bob was a true IA. cornerstone of the Monticello community, leaving an indelible mark on its history. From a very young age,



Bob displayed an interest in newspapers, eventually rising to the position of publisher of the Monticello Express. During his junior year of high school, Bob began his journey in the world of newspapers by taking on the role of sweeping floors and washing windows at the local newspaper, the Monticello Express. It was there that he gained a solid foundation in the newspaper industry, and continued working for the paper after completing high school. In 1974, he purchased the Express, a newspaper he published for decades. His dedication and expertise earned him recognition, including the title of Master Editor Publisher from the Iowa Newspaper Association in 2000.

In a time when many newspapers faced challenges or were absorbed by larger publications, Bob stood steadfast, ensuring the Express remained a vital part of Monticello. His commitment benefited both the community of Monticello and organizations like Camp Courageous.

Bob was unwaveringly devoted to the community of Monticello. He believed that what was good for Monticello was good for him. Throughout his tenure, Bob supported education and never hesitated to promote anything that would benefit Monticello, even if it meant potentially sacrificing revenue.

Bob was one of those individuals who appeared and acted much younger than his years. He was also very competitive. Many remember him participating in 30+ basketball games, playing with an enthusiasm that defied his age, often being decades older than his teammates.

Bob's calm, comforting, and caring personality was truly remarkable. He was always ready to lend a helping hand to anyone in need, and he rarely missed a community event, including those associated with Camp Courageous. Camp Courageous had a special place in Bob's heart, with one of his early editors, Betty Wagner, becoming one of Camp's first board members. The Monticello Express printed the Camp's Courier newsletter for decades. To reduce costs, Bob allowed Camp staff and volunteers to assemble the Courier for 24 consecutive hours over a couple of days.

Bob is survived by his wonderful family, including his wife of 62 years, Janice, and his children Denise Hays (the late Dennis Hays) of Urbandale, Darcey (Mark) Spensley of Monticello, and Dan (Pam) Goodyear of Monticello.

Bob Goodyear was a true pillar of Monticello and Camp Courageous. His passing leaves a significant void in the lives of many, but he leaves behind a beautiful legacy characterized by integrity and unwavering dedication.

Camp Courageous mourns the passing of Charlie Kelchen, 74 of Monticello, IA, who was a true local hero. Charlie's remarkable life included service as a Vietnam War veteran, where he not only demonstrated incredible bravery but

Armed with data but seeking a practical perspective, I reached out to Charlie Kelchen to see if he would be willing to join me in assessing every City facility for true accessibility and what it would take to achieve it. Consequently, like many communities during that era, Monticello embarked on significant projects. Charlie Kelchen was a softly spoken, incredibly kind person-a quiet trailblazer whose influence has endured through the years. Now, 40 years later, with a grandson who relies on a power wheelchair, I extend my personal gratitude to Charlie Kelchen for paving the way for my grandson and future generations. Camp Courageous extends its deepest condolences to Charlie's wife of 50 years, Vicki, daughter Jamie, and all his family and friends. Charlie's legacy will continue to thrive in the lives of the countless individuals he inspired.

Iowa DNR assesses quality of Lake Todd

Thank you to Camp Volunteer and Project Coordinator Jeff Pitlik for inviting Mark Winn with Department the Natural of Resources to visit Lake Todd at Camp



Courageous. Mark is an Iowa DNR Fisheries Management Biologist. He was wonderful, giving Camp great insight into the condition of Lake Todd.

Mark provided Camp a good resource booklet called "Managing Iowa Fisheries-Aquatic Plant Management," which was circulated to the staff and board.

Mark's opening comment was, "Wow... this looks really good for the first week in July. Awesome!!!" One of the reasons Mark sees the pond as excellent is because it contains no invasive species. He could only find good native plants. Iowa ponds should be 20-25% native vegetation covered. Camp mainly has 'Deer Tongue' (leaf like) and Sago (stringier). There was very little algae present. Generally, Lake Todd should clear up by early fall as things die off and look great by mid-fall. Lake Todd's clarity this summer, compared to others, is great.

Special thanks to Craig Lampe, dozens of volunteers, and others, who have been working away on the pond to keep it looking nice for campers to fish, canoe, and paddle boat. Camp also did some raking of the pond, particularly keeping the channel clear that the swimmers used for the Triathlon in August.

Thank you to Mark, Jeff, and the entire DNR! The DNR has been dear friends of Camp Courageous since the Camp's beginning. Camp traded its original 40 acres of land with the Iowa Conservation Commission (DNR) when getting started back in 1972 (the original 40 acres was land locked, with no access).
